

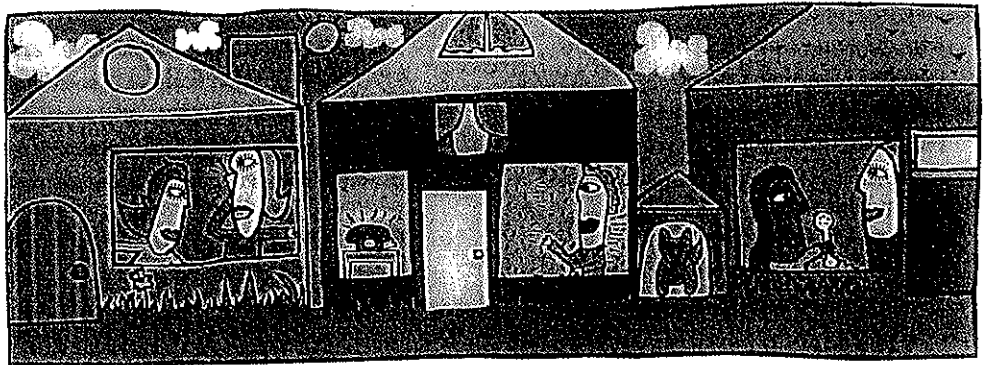

## Tips and Information on Accessing Utility Resources

1. **Look at your cash on hand and decide how much you are able to pay towards this bill. (\$\_\_\_\_\_). Think about when you will have other money coming in and if any of that can go to this bill.**
  
2. **Call the Utility directly:**
  - a) **Ask for the name and/or Operator number of whom you are speaking to.**\_\_\_\_\_
  - b) **Ask for the lowest amount due (\$\_\_\_\_\_ ) and the due date (\_\_\_\_\_ )**
  - c) **Ask if you can make payment arrangements (with the first payment being the amount written in #1). If you are unable to make the first payment or to set up payment arrangements with the Utility contact any applicable formal resources (see Step #3 and #4)**
  - d) **Ask if there are any other options or discounts that the Utility can offer you (CARE, FERA, Medical Baseline, Fixed payments).**
  
3. **Call HEAP for PG&E payment help.**
  - a) **Call HEAP ask for extension 204:**
  - b) **Ask for an appointment to apply for HEAP**
  - c) **Have a copy of your last complete bill (not 15 day or 48 hour notice); HEAP will need a copy of the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> page of your PG&E bill. You will need to show proof of income for the last 6 weeks as well.**
  
4. **Call REACH for PG&E help (see hours on the front of the page)**
  - a) **Contact Salvation Army and make an appointment for REACH**
  - b) **To qualify for REACH you must meet income guidelines and have documentation of an unexpected event that prevented you from paying your PG&E (Example: Loss of income, car repairs, etc).**
